



Analyze	 Pre-test: to understand their existing knowledge and to guide our course syllabus
Design	 Outline and sequence the course syllabus, instructional strategies, content, activities, and assessment
Develop	 - Assemble and create learning content, materials, activities and assessment through ICT tools: • YouTube • Google classroom • Lecturer's Power Point • Core textbook • Links • SlideShare
Implement	- Deliver the materials and instructions (**mid-term course evaluation)
Evaluate	 Formative assessment: class participants, quiz, presentations of group assignment and discussions, and midterm Summative assessment: Final exam
