Course Description

MEDD6143 Planning, Management, Evaluation and Leadership in Early Childhood Education

Course description and objectives

This module provides an overview of how to plan, implement, manage and evaluate early childhood programmes and provide leadership in early childhood settings. Specific topics include: (i) leadership and management in early childhood settings; (ii) programme planning and provision for students; (iii) staff administration; (iv) facilities planning and management; (v) resources management; (vi) student recruitment and working with parents and external parties; and (vii) quality assurance and accountability.

Case studies based on the local context will be used throughout the module. Course participants will also consider the impact of the HKSAR Government's regulations on the administration and management of early childhood programmes.
